In his latest show, transferring to London from a successful run at the Edinburgh Fringe, rising star **Kelly Kingham** discovers that, no matter how hard he tries, he just can't stop the inside bubbling out.

At 50 years of age Kelly suddenly realises it may be entirely possible for a man to die before he's ever really lived. He's been so busy shovelling money into a mortgage, under-achieving at work and disappointing his wife that any thought of happiness completely slipped his mind.

Inside Out is what happens when your coping strategies can no longer cope and the crutches you so desperately cling to are actually holding you back.

Kelly has reached the finals of the **Leicester Square Theatre New Comedian of the Year Awards** and the **NATYs (formerly the Hackney Empire New Act of the Year Awards)** and his solo shows at the Edinburgh, Brighton and Buxton festivals have been highly acclaimed.

Kelly also wrote **Jump: The Musical**, a Fringe smash at the **Pleasance** in 2010. He wrote it from scratch using just a 'how-to' book and sheer bloody-mindedness!
