If you thought that David Cameron and George Osborne were going to be the most infamous upper crust blokes of 2015, then think again: poshboy adventurer **Jasper Cromwell Jones** – the creation of award-winning comedian and TV warm-up man **Joe Bor** - is on the road for his 'Mooning in June' tour of smash Fringe show **This Is Not A Holiday**.

Channeling the spirit of 127 Hours and Touching the Void with the ability of Harry Enfield's Tim Nice But Dim, hapless, upper crust climber Jasper Cromwell Jones is at the top of his game – if that game was charades.

To start this debut double-bill show, we first meet Jasper at the launch of his book about his most 'celebrated' expedition – and more specifically about what went wrong on it; the treacherous climbs, treacherous friends (played by **Jack Whitehall**, courtesy of a filmed cameo) and the unfortunate death of his fellow climber. Whoops.

In the second half, we join Jasper just before he learns that his real father is in the Outback. Our 'hero' sets out to be reunited with his daddy, but his mission to Oz becomes more about survival than retrieval, and he's further hindered by the creepy behavior of his obsessive fan Gemma (**Samantha Baines**). Luckily Bear Grylls proves to be much more useful. Or does he?

Joe Bor's creation Jasper Cromwell Jones has been well-received, with 4 and 5 star reviews, and optioned by TV company Yalli (Shed Media). Joe is in huge demand as a warm up and he has MC'd for **The Graham Norton Show**, **Mock the Week**, **Never Mind the Buzzcocks** and **Sunday Night at the Palladium**. His comedy career has seen him crowned with numerous accolades including the winner of **Jewish Comedian of the Year**, but also **Best Value Show at Leicester Comedy Festival**, and he was a finalist for **Comedian of the Year**. Playing the prestige comedy clubs and festivals as a stand-up, Joe has also performed as part of two sketch groups and, in 2011, he wrote and directed his first play, **Who Killed the Counsellor?** Joe was named in The **Daily Telegraph's** top people to follow on Twitter and has received Funniest Joke accolades from the **Daily Mail**, **The Independent**, **The Scotsman** and **Zoo** magazine among others.
