There was a room in Alfie's high school called Room 5. It was a place for the weak and the nerdy. It was Alfie's safe haven. That is, until he noticed that Room 5 was being used around the school as a kind of slur. As in, "he's a bit Room 5, isn't he?" Alfie never returned to Room 5 after that. But in other ways, he never left.

Alfie's second Edinburgh fringe show, My Apologies to the Chef, is a standup show about belonging. It's about that feeling you get when you arrive at the pub and your friends say "here he is!" It's about trying to think of what to say during a phone call to your grieving dad. It's about playing a basketball game with strangers. The show is by turns cerebral and silly. And it asks the question, can you choose where you belong?

It also features artists, nerds, retail workers, burglars, fruit farmers, friends, family and enemies. It's not about chefs.
